

Guidance on Alumni and Student Surveys for Periodic Review

The following notes provide guidance and recommended practice for carrying out additional alumni and student surveys for periodic review – including template messages and questionnaires.

Planning and administering surveys

- Surveys must be completed prior to the SED and supporting documentation deadline;
- Surveys are delivered online (emailing students with a link to a web-based questionnaire). LSHTM has a subscription to an easy-to-use software tool for designing and administering online surveys;
- Alumni Surveys are administered by the Alumni Relations and Annual Giving team
 and can be sent to any students who completed the programme in the past five
 years (excluding any who failed, as they are unlikely to appreciate contact);
- Current Student Surveys are administered by the TSO/DLO and are for currentlyregistered students only, excluding any who are on interruption of studies when the survey is launched.;
- · Applicant Surveys are administered by the Registry;
- Survey emails should preserve the students' anonymity. They should include a message from the Programme Director providing a link to a survey questionnaire and giving a deadline for responses.

Survey content and questionnaires

- **Key questions**, as per the review as a whole, will be whether the programme is relevant, competitive, and achieves set objectives.
- Standard questionnaire templates: The following questionnaire templates
 (based on work by Dr Paul A Bates, Liverpool School of Tropical Medicine, later
 updated by Dr Nick Dorrell and Dr Anna Foss at LSHTM) plus covering messages
 are intended starting points for surveying alumni and current students. However,
 these are not prescriptive and programme teams may adapt these surveys or
 develop their own.
- Programme Teams may find it useful to review questionnaires used by other programmes in the past. Please contact either the Programme Teams or Quality & Academic Standards Office for more information.

Survey results

- Reporting survey results: If a survey is carried out, then at least one member of the Programme Team should take the time to look through all results and read through all comments. The Review Panel may wish to do the same, or may wish simply to see a summary or have key topics raised during the Review Panel meeting. The online survey can present basic quantitative results and qualitative comments. A copy of all results and feedback received should be kept in the review file.
- **Feeding back to respondents:** Alumni or students who have been surveyed should be to thank them for their participation and give a synopsis of the feedback received (e.g. through a message from the Review Panel).

ALUMNI SURVEY – EXAMPLE INTRODUCTORY NOTE

(this may easily be adapted if sending something similar to current students)

All details you provide will be held securely and in confidence. Responses are anonymous and cannot be attributed to you personally, though if you are happy to identify yourself then you're welcome to do so. Results and comments will be shared with a small team of LSHTM staff plus an external reviewer Professor , University of , and summarised in a final report. We would also appreciate it if you could forward the link to this survey to any other programme alumni you are in touch with who may have changed their contact details since leaving LSHTM. If this has been the case for you, then at the end of the

questionnaire there is a link to the alumni website, through which you can update the details LSHTM holds for you.
