Graduates have the right to apply for direct entry at Registered Associate Nutritionist level to the UKVRN (UK Voluntary Register of Nutritionists), which entitles them to use the letters ANutr after their names. This is a mark of professionalism, and an indication of quality assuring potential employers that graduates have covered set competencies, making them more employable.
