

IN THE MATTER of JEAN ALISON CARR Spinster

I, ANITA MAUD CARR of Nutbourne Manor Near Pulborough
in the County of Sussex Widow make Oath and say as follows :-

1. I am the Mother of the above named Patient and was
appointed Receiver of her estate by the Order dated 30th
July 1934. *Order was Sated 27.9.34*

2. Except for short intervals such as holidays during which
she stays at Hotels or with friends the Patient resides with
me at Nutbourne Manor aforesaid. She has considerably
improved in health and is able to occupy her time in a more
or less normal manner, but she is still not physically strong
and has to rest a great deal.

3. Pursuant to the direction of the Master given on the
11th November 1936 the Patient receives the whole of her
income except what is required for Receivership expenses and
percentage and she expends it as she thinks fit. At the
present time, the monthly sum of £65 is paid to the Patient's
banking account from the Receivership Account.

4. The fact that I am the Receiver causes my daughter to
feel some resentment and is a source of grievance on her part
because to some extent I have control over her affairs. Having
regard to the fact that she resides with me this feeling on
the part of the Patient is inclined to make matters difficult
between us at times. In these circumstances I consider it
would be better for me to relinquish the Receivership and I
should prefer to do so and suggest that my eldest son Arthur
Carr of Ardleigh Hall, Ardleigh Colchester in the County of
Essex a Captain in H. M. 5th Inniskilling Dragoon Guards
should be appointed in my place. He is quite willing to
act and is fully aware of the circumstances of the case. He

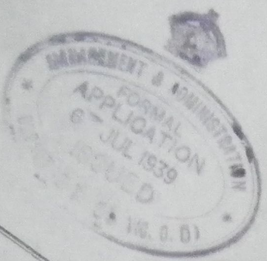
