Southampton make oath and say as follows:-

1. I am a Physician and have been consulted by Miss  
Beatrice Ruth Alexander of Chilfrome Maiden Newton  
Dorchester in the County of Dorset.

2. I examined the above-named Beatrice Ruth Alexander  
on the 16th day of June 1939 with a view to ascertaining  
her condition and state of mind and for the reasons here-  
inafter appearing I am of opinion that the said Beatrice  
Ruth Alexander is of sound mind and quite capable of  
managing her own affairs.

3. I base the conclusions stated in the preceding  
paragraph on the following grounds namely:-

(a) Although her reactions were somewhat slow she  
answered in a perfectly intelligent manner questions  
which I put to her concerning her life and the manage-  
ment of her money.

(b) She appeared to me to be quite capable of  
appreciating the value of money and the importance of  
paying her accounts regularly.

4. From the comparatively short interview which said  
interview was the first occasion on which I have seen  
the said Beatrice Ruth Alexander I am strongly of the

opinion that under no circumstances could it be said  
with fairness that she is incapable of managing her  
own life and her own financial affairs.
