First Assessment

- **When?**
- **Forms to complete**
 - Baseline visit
 - DLQI
 - SF-36
- **What we need to remember**



First Assessment

- After first screening, consent and enrollment
- First assessment consist of baseline visit and quality of life questionnaires (DLQI and SF-36)
- Important to ask about
 - ENL details
 - Medical history – including allergies
 - Medication
 - Use of medication with interaction with MTX
 - Symptoms
 - Physical examination – height and **weight**
 - Laboratory tests
 - Chest x-ray

First Assessment

- Complete the DLQI and SF-36
- Take note of EESS
- Confirm medication in use and allergies
- Take note of laboratory tests
- **VERIFY THE RANDOMISATION NUMBER**
- **TAKE NOTE OF THE STUDY MEDICATION PACKAGE NUMBER**
- Prescribe the additional medication needed
- Check the next appointment and write it down on the participant card
- Ask the participant if he/she have any question
- Send the participant to the pharmacist
