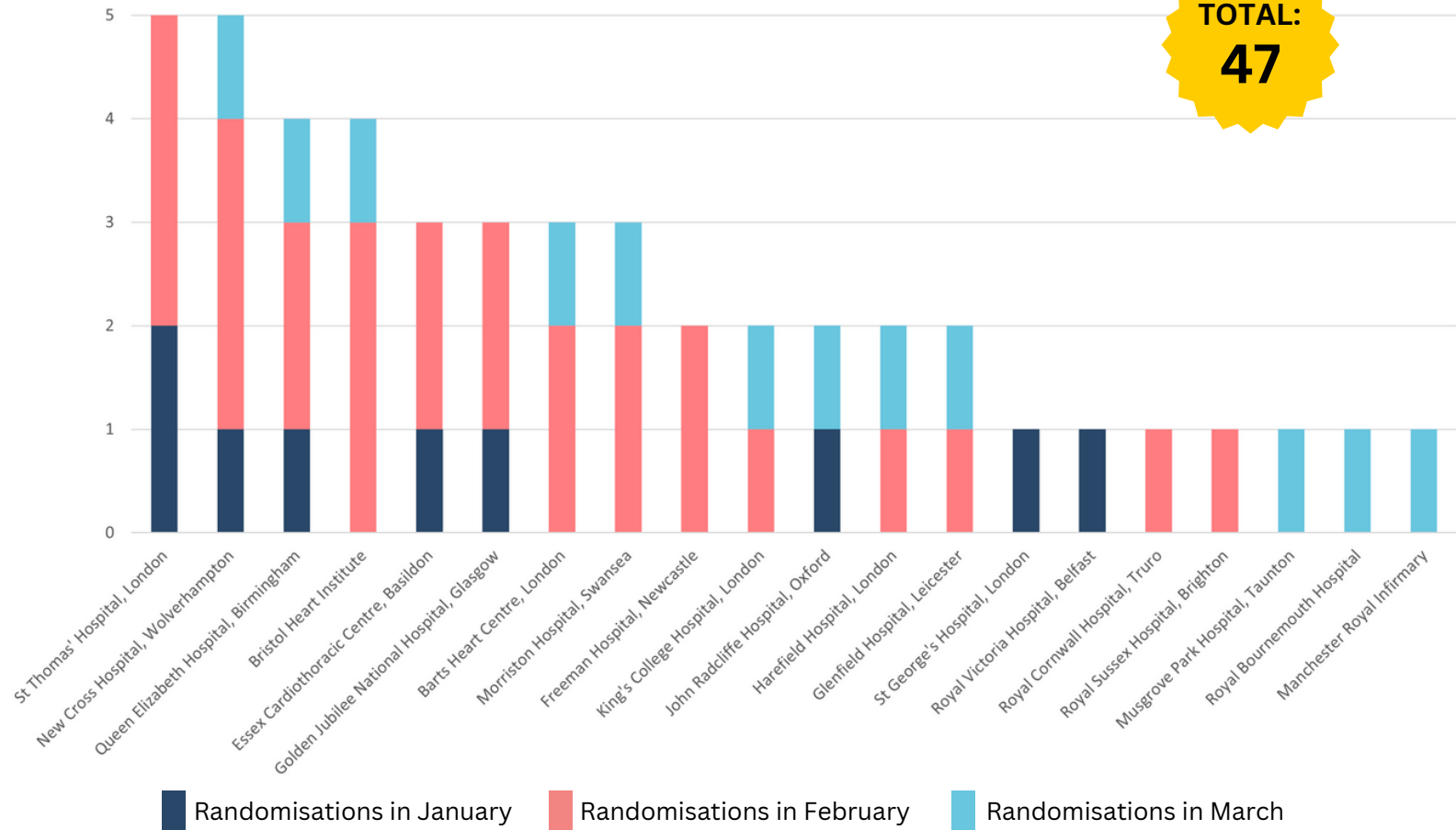

EVENT REPORTING REMINDERS

The Clinical Events Committee (CEC) have now begun validating reported events for the trial.

As many of you will know, events are reported by site staff using the CHIP-BCIS3 eCRF. The CEC will then review these reported events, except for ppMI.

We would like to kindly remind all site staff to upload **all** supporting documentation for all patients, to the eCRF system, to help the CEC make an accurate classification.

All supporting documentation **must not** contain any patient identifiable information. This includes names, dates of birth and addresses. The CHIP-BCIS3 study ID must be used. If patient identifiable data is present on the documentation, please note that it must be permanently obscured before being uploaded. Any reference to the randomised trial treatment must also be permanently obscured.
